

.22 Rimfire – Steel Plate Shooting Match!

Saturday, August 13, 2011

**Match Location: SFA Shooting Range located near Fallon, NV
3.5 miles north of Rattlesnake Raceway, entrance on Indian Lakes Road**

Registration 8:00 – 8:55 a.m. Match begins at 9:00 a.m.

Any .22 caliber (less .22 WMR) Rimfire firearm allowed. Holsters NOT required; all shooters will start from the “Low Ready” position. 10 round limit; No reloading allowed; Exceptions: Double Action revolver shooters may reload for a total of 10 expended rounds; Single Action shooters may reload until a winner is determined.

“Round Robin” tournament format. Shooters compete until losing a predetermined number of matches (aka “Outs”) dependent upon the total number of registered shooters (minimum of three outs.)

- 1) Handgun Limited Division: Open (iron) sights, double action revolvers and semi auto pistols. Shooters classed by shooting ability; Classes: Master, A, B, C.
- 2) Handgun Unlimited Division: Optical sights double action revolvers and semi auto pistols. All shooters in same class.
- 3) Handgun Single Action Division: All shooters in same class.
- 4) Rifle (open/iron sights) Division: All shooters in same class.
- 5) Rifle (optical sights) Division: All shooters in same class.
- 6) “Retro Rifle” (lever & pump action) Division: All shooters in same class.

Course of fire: Two firing positions; from 15 yards, each shooter engages:

Master, A & B Classes & Unlimited Division: SIX targets. C Class: FOUR targets.

Single Action Division: FIVE targets.

Rifle Divisions: SIX targets

The first shooter to fell his/her array of targets wins that match.

1st, 2nd, & 3rd Place trophies for each Division & Class.

Each registered shooter will also receive a ticket to win drawing prizes!

Eye and ear protection REQUIRED. SAFETY FIRST!

**Entry fees: Adults, \$15 per division with Option to “Buy Up” one Class, \$5
Youth (under 18), \$5 per division with Option to “Buy Up” one Class, \$5**

BBQ lunch: \$5

Bring plenty of ammunition! **If you have no holster, you must have a case, rug or other container to transport handguns to/from the firing line;** limited spares may be available.
